## Guide to Diving Etiquette at the Rezza

Can all members please respect the following practices:-

1. Park as close together as possible in the car park as diving on Sundays has increased and the car park is becoming congested.
2. The gate to enter the rezza will be closed from 09.30 to minimize congestion and ensure safe operations during dive time.
3. When claiming your spot on the jetty please keep it compact allowing room for other users
4. To allow space for confined water trainees, avoid using the end of the jetty (by the launch ramp) for kitting up.
5. Similarly avoid diving around the jetty adjacent to the launch ramp to minimize stirring up silt and reducing vis for instruction sessions.
6. When you are ready to dive(s) move your kit bags etc. to the back of the jetty promptly, allowing space for following divers.
7. Smoking and vaping is prohibited inside and the outside front of the garage.
8. If making drinks in the kitchen, please observe one-in-one-out rules during covid restrictions. Clean up any spills and ensure used mugs are washed up and paper cups disposed of in bins provided and please remember to pay for your drinks.
9. If using the club house, changing rooms and/or toilets please observe one-in-one-out rules during covid restrictions.

Items 4 & 5 will not be necessary when pool training has resumed.

Please follow all current Covid restrictions as noted in items 8 & 9

These measures will be kept under review and changes made as required.
